Revitalisation

- Works :
- All the existing 3 buildings will be preserved
 - A new 2-storey multi-function hall, namely, The Cube (600 m²) will be built to connect the two blocks at 2/F and 3/F to improve the physical connectivity and visitor circulation, as well as to create extra covered event space at ground level and the public open space at rooftop.
 - A new glazed canopy between the two blocks at 6/F plus the covered event space under The Cube will make up a total of 1,000 m² for hosting semi-outdoor activities.
 - An Underground Interpretation Area (230 m²) will be constructed to display and conserve the archaeological remnants of the Former Central School, as well as provision of historic photo galleries.
 - In addition to the existing entrance located at Aberdeen Street, 3 new entrances will be built, including one each at the junction of Hollywood Road and Aberdeen Street, Staunton Street, and Shing Wong Street respectively.
