

Remarks, Terms & Conditions of Wow Exhibition and its Activities

I. Exhibition (General Exhibition Area and Interactive Zone)

1. The opening hours of the WOW Exhibition are from 11am to 7pm.
2. Certain areas of the exhibition will not be open to non-participants until completion of certain special activities, if any, in the interactive area.
3. All facilities in the Exhibition Area are for public enjoyment. The organizer PMQ reserves its rights to indemnify the user(s) who cause(s) the damage, if any.
4. In case of any damage and loss of personal property, PMQ and the coordinators of the exhibition will only notify the Police and shall not be liable to any reimbursement or indemnification.
5. PMQ and the coordinators thereof and therein shall bear no responsibility for any accidents during the exhibition or in the venue. In case of serious accidents where immediate medical care is required, PMQ will call an ambulance and send the participant(s) concerned to hospital and inform the family member of participant(s).
6. PMQ reserves the right to photograph and film all activities of the programmes and all participants' projects/works. Participants agree that PMQ takes ownership of all photographs and films it takes or on its behalf, and the photographs and films can be used in any function for publicity use.

8. In the event of any dispute, the decision of PMQ shall be final.

3. Participants are advised to report presence with their respective confirmation notice emails (either shown on the mobile device or in printed form) for verification purpose at least 10 minutes before the activities.

The following arrangements will be made for the inclement weather conditions without further notice:

<p>Exhibition area (General Exhibition area and Interactive Zone) (opening hours: 11am - 7pm)</p>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • When the Tropical Cyclone Warning Signal No.3 or below, or the Amber Rainstorm Warning Signal is in force, the Exhibition will remain open. • When the Tropical Cyclone Warning Signal No.8 or above, or the Black Rainstorm Warning Signal is still in force before 11am, the Exhibition area will cease operation and will be close when either of the said signals is still in force after 1pm. • When the Black Rainstorm Warning Signal is no longer in force or the Tropical Cyclone Warning Signal has been changed to No.3 or below between 9am and 1pm, the Exhibition will reopen in 2 hours. • When the Tropical Cyclone Warning Signal No.8 or above, or the Black Rainstorm Warning Signal is issued during the opening hours, the Exhibition might remain partially open or be close. All visitors and participants are suggested to stay in safe areas or to leave under safe circumstances.
<p>Forum:</p>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • When the Tropical Cyclone Warning Signal No.3 or below, or the Amber / Red Rainstorm Warning Signal is in force, the Forum will continue. • When the Tropical Cyclone Warning Signal No.8 or above, or the Black Rainstorm Warning Signal is issued 2 hours before and in force during the Forum, it will be cancelled. • When the Black Rainstorm Warning Signal is no longer in force or the Tropical Cyclone Warning Signal has been changed to No.3 or below 2 hours before the Forum, it will continue. • When the Tropical Cyclone Warning Signal No.8 or above, or the Black Rainstorm Warning Signal is issued during the Forum, it might continue or be cancelled. All visitors and participants are suggested to stay in safe areas or to leave under safe circumstances.

1. In inclement weather conditions and for safety reasons, PMQ reserves its rights of final arbitration on the cancellation or rearrangement of the entire event and its activities.
2. If circumstances allow, PMQ might try to arrange make-up activities for the cancelled ones at the time designated by PMQ.
