

Terms and Conditions of #PMQGiftYourTime Jewellery Workshop & Taste Visit

All participants must read the following notes, terms and conditions before registration, and are assumed to have acknowledged and accepted the following terms and conditions after registration:

A. Notice and Privacy Statement

- 1. Participants must present your PMQGiftYourTime ticket confirmation email at Loupe on the day of the workshop, 15 minutes before the workshop starts for registration, and redeem a Black Sugar Coffee HK\$80 voucher; Also, simply register at PMQ Taste Library by presenting PMQGiftYourTime ticket confirmation email on the day you wish to visit (except Monday), then you can enter reading area in Taste Library and enjoy the book collection with over 5000 books. Both the voucher and the Taste Library entry admission expire on 31 August, 2022.
- 2. Workshop equipment and materials are provided by the participating unit ('Loupe'), and Loupe is responsible for the quality of the workshop. Participants, please use it with care. The organizer ('PMQ') shall not be liable for any losses, damage or personal injury (including but not limited to direct or indirect), induced by workshop activities.
- 3. Loupe reserves the right to change the content of activities, instructors, speakers, or to arrange substitute instructors when instructors are absent without prior notice to participants.
- 4. PMQ and Loupe will take photos or video recordings during workshops, courses and activities. All photos or videos taken/recorded may be collected, used, modified, disclosed and shared for public display or promotional purposes.
- 5. The photos and videos shall become the property of Loupe. Loupe has the portrait rights of the participants in the photo or video. No prior or further notice will be made to participants regarding the portrait rights in the photos/videos.
- 6. After completing the workshop or course, the participant will automatically become a Loupe member without prior notice.
- 7. No compensation will be made for any loss or damage after receiving the Black Sugar Coffee Cash Voucher.
- 8. In case of any disputes, PMQ reserves the right of final decision.



B. Personal and site precautions on hygiene

- 1. All visitors are required to wear face masks, undergo body temperature checks and use alcohol-based hand sanitiser to clean their hands upon entry.
- 2. When entering the workshop (Loupe), all participants must register their personal information and fill in a health declaration form before entering the venue. All participants must wear masks and maintain a social distance of 1.5 meters in any area of the venue.
- 3. Participants should not enter the venue and seek medical advice as soon as possible if they have developed fever or symptoms of respiratory infection; have had close contact with any people who were exposed to or tested positive for COVID-19 (whether in Hong Kong or overseas); are undergoing compulsory quarantine or have not completed the mandatory testing.
- 4. If necessary, the on-site staff will provide participants with epidemic prevention advice and have the right to ask participants who do not comply with the hygiene measures at the venue to leave the venue.

C. Arrangements under Tropical Cyclone or Rainstorm Warning

In the event of the following bad weather, PMQ will make the following arrangements without individual notification or prior notice:

- 1. If the Hong Kong Observatory issues a black rainstorm warning signal, or a tropical cyclone warning signal No. 8 or above is hoisted, or is still in force 2 hours before the event, the event will be cancelled.
- 2. If the Hong Kong Observatory has lowered or cancelled the black rainstorm warning signal, or changed the tropical cyclone warning signal No. 3 or below two hours before the event, the event will be conducted as usual.
- 3. When the event is in progress, if the Hong Kong Observatory issues a black rainstorm warning signal, or a tropical cyclone warning signal No. 8 or above is hoisted, the event will be continued or cancelled depending on the situation to ensure that conditions are safe.
- 4. In the event of bad weather, PMQ reserves the right to reschedule or cancel the event for safety reasons, even if there are no warning signals issued.
- 5. For activities cancelled due to bad weather, the paid amount will be refunded.

D. Cancellation & Refund arrangement

- Date and time of the workshop must be selected when purchasing the ticket.
 Cancellation of workshops or amendment in date or times of workshops are not allowed;
 all workshop arrangements and schedules are subject to change depending on the final decision of the participating unit Loupe.
- 2. No transfers or refund of the workshops will be arranged for any participants who are absent, late or wish to leave early for personal reasons in the workshops. PMQ reserves the right to determine a forfeit. Workshop fees are non-refundable.
- 3. If the activity of the day is cancelled due to inclement weather or the latest arrangement of COVID-19, etc., PMQ will arrange a refund, with a deduction of HK\$10 as a handling fee.
- 4. In case of any disputes, PMQ reserves the right of final decision.
